7.



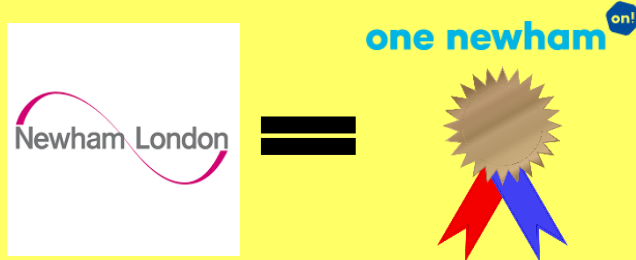
We want to be fully involved in decisions about when we can run services that are paid for by the Council.
